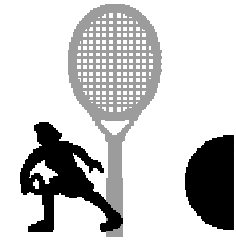

FIGURE SKATING AND ATHLETICS

2010 Steven has gained a place on the Regional Development Pathway Team, which is run by the National Skating Association. He has competed abroad in Austria representing Great Britain for the first time. Finished fourth, beating the current British Novice Champion.

Nov 2010 Qualifying and competing in the British Championships at Sheffield, coming fifth.

Jan 2010, Steven decided to try Pairs figure skating. He and his partner passed the six pairs tests in record time enabling them to compete in their first major competition at the beginning of this month. They finished second.

2010 Steven has now moved up to Junior level (in solo skating), and will be competing against a much higher level of Skaters.

Steven is still competing regularly for Chelmsford Athletic Club on both track and cross country, including National Cross Country competitions.
