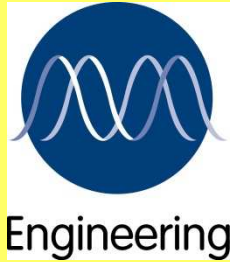

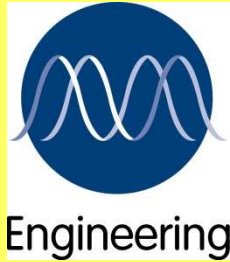






The Results - A2

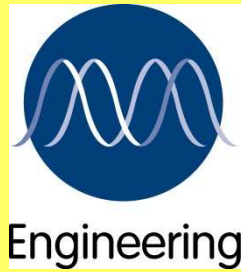
- Pass rate - 99%

- Grades A* to C - 71%



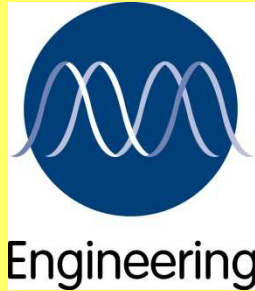

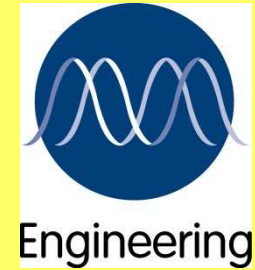


The Admissions Process

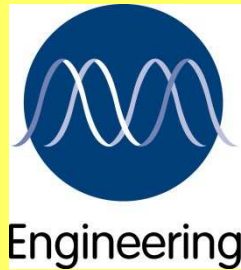

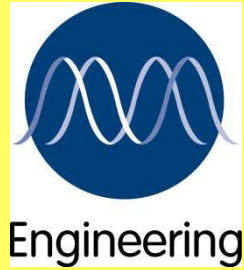

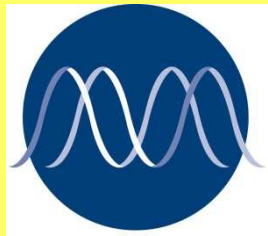
What subjects should you choose?

What is the minimum entry requirement?

- You will need at least 5 GCSEs at Grade C or higher, including both English Language and Mathematics
- In most cases you will need to achieve at least a Grade B in any subject that you are currently studying if you wish to study it in Year 12
- If you wish to study a new subject (e.g. Psychology), you will need to check the prospectus for any requirements they may have, particularly in English or Mathematics

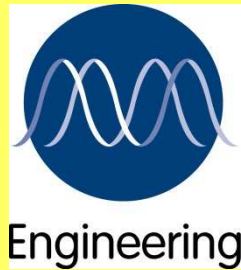
